Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions:

PTSO Meetings: Lunch is provided for the 11:30 am monthly meeting. A group of volunteers provide the food.

Hospitality: This committee plans and provides food and treats for teachers throughout the year, usually once per month. Needed: set-up, serving, monetary donations, food preparation and food purchase.

Conference Day Meal for teachers: Meal provided during scheduled Parent-Teacher Conference day.

CAP Conference Meal: for teachers during scheduled CAP conferences.

After-Prom: Held following the Jr.-Sr. Prom, this is a way to extend the fun and excitement of prom in a safe, alcohol-free environment. Volunteers needed to solicit community donations and to organize and oversee the project with student input.

Teacher Appreciation: Plan activities for the week, usually involves serving one meal or event, treats, etc.

EOC Exams: volunteers to hand-out snacks & drinks to students--approx. 1.5 hours per day.

Scholarship Assembly: organize and staff the event.
