

_____ **Tuesday Folders.** We still have some teachers needing help on Tuesday mornings. Help teachers with handing back student work, as well as information from the school. Volunteers will need to be here in the mornings on Tuesdays to do this. Please note: You may be assisting in a classroom that is not your child's.

_____ **Book Fair.** Please respond quickly if you'd like to help out with the October Book Fair. For those with an hour or two to spare the week of the Book Fair, volunteers will offer general customer service. The spring Book Fair will need volunteers in April.

_____ **Fall Carnival.** It takes a lot of help and organization to pull off the Fall Carnival, but there are jobs to suit every amount of time and interest imaginable!

_____ **Elephant Extravaganza.** We need volunteers once a month to suit up as Ellie and Eddie Elephant.

_____ **Staff Appreciation/Hospitality.** Approximately once a quarter, volunteers plan, create and serve a luncheon buffet to give a tasty little something back to the teachers and staff at WES. With enough volunteers, participation could be limited to every other menu.

_____ **School Store.** Every Friday morning, the Willowbrook school store is open for business. Volunteers help sell and organize items.

_____ **Box Tops/Labels.** Another great and easy fundraiser! These helpers prepare turned in Box Tops for Education to be submitted for reimbursement. This is a year-round project, but only a limited number of collections are held each year, so the time required is highly flexible; some duties can be done at home.

_____ **Library Assistance.** The Cornerstone library is often in need of volunteers to help shelve books.

_____ **General Volunteer List.** This list is contacted based on the needs of the programs that run throughout the year, including the Spring Fundraiser (which will be determined later this fall). As the opportunities arise, volunteers will be contacted and can choose whether the specific opportunity works with their schedule. In addition to the Spring Fundraiser, examples of such activities may include: Picture Days (spring only this year); WES Open House; recycling efforts; occasional celebrations/parties; Christmas parade; and additional programs as they may develop.
