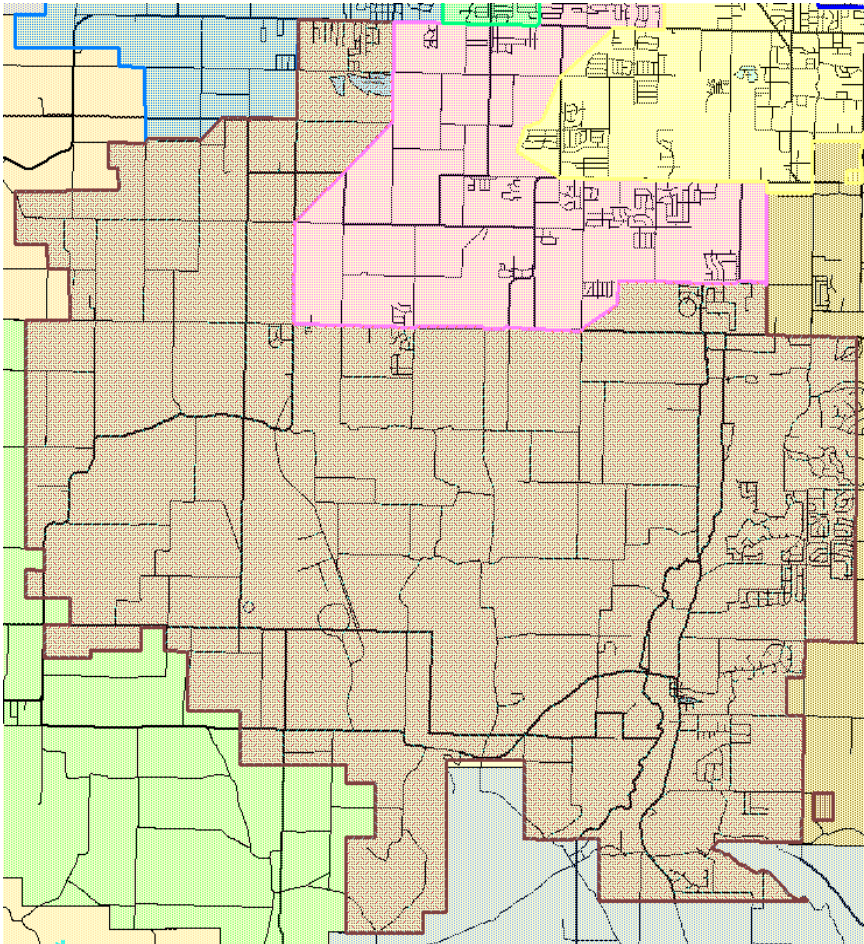


# Central Park Elementary

## Central Park Elementary zone boundary -

**West Boundary, South Boundary and East Boundary** contained by Bentonville School District boundary.

Begin **North Boundary** at Bentonville School District boundary at intersection Dorsey Lee Rd and Shady Acres Rd > continue east, north of Shady Acres Rd, to intersection Shady Acres Rd and N Tycoon Rd > continue east, north of Huber Rd, to intersection Huber Rd and Wade Dr > continue east, north of Huber Rd, to intersection Huber Rd and N Vaughn Rd (N Hwy 279) > follow N Vaughn Rd (N Hwy 279) north to intersection N Vaughn Rd (N Hwy 279) and W Centerton Blvd (Hwy 102) > follow W Centerton Blvd (Hwy 102) east > continue on E Centerton Blvd (Hwy 102) to intersection E Centerton Blvd (Hwy 102) and S Fish Hatchery Rd > continue south on S Fish Hatchery Rd to Ginn Rd > follow Ginn Rd south to intersection Ginn Rd and Holloway Rd > continue southeast to intersection S Vaughn Rd and Anglin Rd > follow S Vaughn Rd south to intersection S Vaughn Rd and SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) > follow SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) east to intersection SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) and SW Lee Harris Rd > continue east, north of SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12), to intersection SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) and Mill Dam Rd > follow SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) east to intersection SW Regional Airport Blvd (Hwy 12) and Nomad Rd > continue east to intersection S Morningstar Rd and Windmill Rd > continue northeast and east, north of Windmill Rd to intersection SW Bright Rd and SW Gator Blvd > follow SW Gator Blvd to intersection SW Gator Blvd and Hwy 112 > follow Hwy 112 east to intersection Hwy 112 and Elk Rd > continue east, north of Elk Rd, to district boundary.

Zones created to include student population living within the immediate area to the closest school campus first, using the natural geographic and demographic areas, main through streets, transportation corridors, and transportation zones to divide the Bentonville School District into contiguous zones with a balanced student population with room for future growth. Zones adjusted to accommodate equitable free and reduced lunch population.
