2. Bentonville High School events requiring a large venue.
3. Bentonville Public Schools Fine Arts groups.
4. Bentonville Public Schools Administrator(s) meetings
5. Arend Arts Center presented and sponsored events
6. Walton Arts Center Sponsored events
7. Bentonville Community non-profit organizations
8. For profit organizations.

The priorities of this chart will be applied along with a first come, first serve mentality. If a higher priority group attempts to reserve the AAC at the last minute, and that date was previously reserved earlier by lower priority group, the higher priority group should not assume their date will be scheduled. **Groups requesting use of the AAC must be comprised of 100 persons or more.**

Category 6, 7, & 8 organizations will be charged a rental fee.

AAC management shall reserve the right to refuse a reservation or rental of AAC facilities for any event, activity or performance.

AAC management shall reserve the right to refuse a reservation or rental of AAC facilities for any event, activity or performance if it determines that such event, activity or performance or the anticipated audience response to such event, activity, or performance may cause damage or unusual risk to AAC facilities and/or patrons.

AAC management shall reserve the right to refuse a reservation or rental of AAC facilities if it deems that any event, activity, or performance is inappropriate to the general rules of conduct, or cause disruption to the learning environment of Bentonville Public Schools.

AAC management shall reserve the right to refuse a reservation or rental of AAC facilities if it deems that any event, activity or performance shall violate any Local, State, or Federal laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or the opinion of the Board of Health.
