Adventure Club is a state licensed school-age childcare program for children in kindergarten through sixth grade.

Care is available at your child's school from 6 am until school starts in the morning and from the time school dismisses until 6 pm.

We are also open for full days during teacher in-service, holiday breaks, snow days and we offer a full day summer program.

Adventure Club is located at all elementary schools and middle schools during the school year.

All Adventure Club elementary schools have achieved a 3 out of 3 star rating from the state of Arkansas' Better Beginnings Quality Rating System.

Activities are planned to help develop the whole child: socially, emotionally, physically and mentally. These activities provide an enriching experience so that children can have fun and learn in a safe environment.

Afternoon activities include: snack, outside or gym time, interest centers, enrichment activities, homework help, as well as many other fun and educational activities.

Staff are CPR certified and have been trained in basic first aid. They receive 25 hours of professional development each year. Many are seeking a degree in education.



There is a \$100 registration/activity fee due at the time of enrollment. The weekly tuition is \$50 for before and/or after school care. Additional fees apply for Adventure Club's full day programs.
