Building Bridges is a state licensed childcare program for children ages 6 weeks through Pre-Kindergarten.

Care is available on 3 BPS campuses. BHS and Wildcat Way Infant/Toddler Centers hours are 7:00 am to 5:30 pm. Central Pre-K Center's hours are 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Building Bridges accepts children on a full time basis only. We do not enroll children for part time care.

All of the Building Bridges centers have achieved a 3 out of 3 star rating from the state of Arkansas' Better Beginnings Quality Rating System.

Program Goals

Our goal is to provide quality childcare. Activities are planned to help develop the whole child: socially, emotionally, physically and mentally. These activities provide an enriching experience. Children can have fun and learn in a safe environment.

Daily activities include: meals, outside play time, free choice learning centers, enrichment time, small group time, circle time, as well as many other fun and educational activities.

The majority of our staff is CPR certified and have been trained in basic first aid. They receive 25 hours of professional development each year.

Many are degreed or have a Child Development Associates Credential.

The registration fee is \$100. The weekly base rate is \$155 for infants, 6 weeks to 18 months, \$145 for 18 months to 3 years, \$135 for 3 year olds, and \$125 for 4-6 year olds. Building Bridges is a year round program and is open during all holiday weeks and the summer.
